



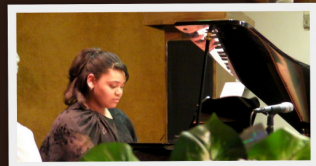

The message of these songs and the spirit in which they were presented melted the hearts of segregationist and opened doors of opportunity for their people. They were ambassadors who traveled the world and stood before, presidents, kings and queens with impeccable character and dignity.

Jubilee Music Enrichment challenges youths to emulate the dignity and discipline of the Jubilee Singers and to stand as leaders who provoke positive change in their community.
